## New Online Meal Payment Portal for Students and Staff

Dear Parents/Guardians and DCSS Staff,

Dodge County School Nutrition Program is utilizing a new system for viewing meal activity and making payments for school meals starting 2024-2025 school year.

All Dodge County students receive BREAKFAST and LUNCH at **NO COST** under the CEP program.

### Community Eligibility Provision Explained:

The intent of CEP is to improve access to school meals at no cost in eligible Local Educational Agencies (LEA) and school(s) with an Identified Student Percentage (ISP) of 40% or more. ISP is determined by the total Identified Students for school(s) divided by the total Enrolled Students for the same school(s). CEP eliminates the administrative burden of collecting household applications and prevents student meal charges.

However, staff and parents wishing to apply funds to an account to be used for cafeteria purchases, may create a new account at <https://www.linqconnect.com>.

Dodge County School Nutrition no longer uses MySchoolBucks, you are unable to make payments with your old MySchoolBucks account. The remaining balances and credits will roll over to Linq Connect. To continue making meal payments, please create a new account at: <https://www.linqconnect.com>.
