


Area of decrease was involved families, every other area either went up or maintained.

# MIS 1 and 2

Priority Performance Challenge-AKA What's the most important problem to solve for kids at Wilson?

CMAS and STAR both have a large group of students who are not yet proficient (72% in ELA and 85% in math). We also have a large group of students who are nearing proficiency (at the approaching band).

MIS #1: Best First Instruction -**Coherence in Tier 1 Instruction:** At Wilson, we will implement and refine, through coaching cycles, a comprehensive instructional infrastructure to support high quality instruction.


## Action Steps for MIS 1:


- Utilizing strengths of all staff to implement peer coaching and observation.
- CLDE focus- data analysis and PD around language strategies that support all learners in the classroom.
- Literacy planning PLCs that support implementation of language strategies and text-first planning.
- Ongoing coaching cycles to continue to norm on instruction throughout the building.
- Focus on indicators of high-quality instruction- coaching on those items throughout Wilson.

Wilson High-Level Highlights from Parent 5E Survey 2023

Increased communication from admin to community. Increased communication from teachers to community.


