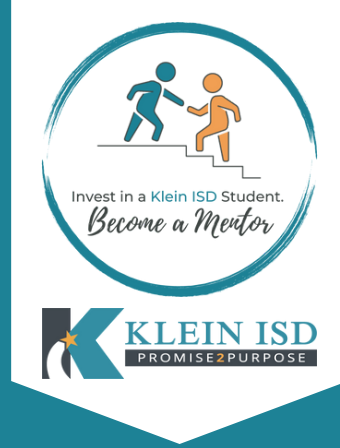


KLEIN ISD VOLUNTEER MENTOR PROGRAM



WHAT IS MENTORING?

Adult mentors volunteer to help students from elementary through high school achieve success by spending one-on-one time together each week on shared activities while listening and providing encouragement. The key to mentoring success is the relationship and bond between the mentor and student.

MENTOR REQUIREMENTS

- Commit to a minimum of a one-school year frame
- Meet with their mentee once per week, on campus, for 30 minutes
- Participate in a one-hour required Klein ISD training session
- Meet the district's volunteer criteria
- Adhere to the Klein ISD Mentor Program Guidelines
