Access to Learning Support

After school tutorial service either online or in-person; summer enrichment programs and transition activities, school supplies and school transportation



Access to Rest

Access to Homeless Education and community resources and support. Students experiencing homelessness and their families, are eligible to request a stay at a hotel for up to 5 nights to attend school. Students must be registered in school and qualify under McKinney Vento



Access to Health and Self-Care

Prescription eyeglasses, hygiene kit, food, and other personal care items/clothing



Access to Training

Parent trainings and Staff Professional Development to heighten the understanding, identifying and removing the barriers to education
