Dear Parent(s)/Guardian(s):

Your child is attending a school receiving Title I federal funds through the Elementary and Secondary Education Act (ESEA). At the beginning of each school year, local educational agencies receiving Title I funds must notify parents whose student(s) attend a Title I school that they may request and be provided information regarding the professional qualifications of the student's classroom teachers in a timely manner. Information provided upon a request will include, at a minimum:

1. Whether the student's teacher
 - a. Has met State qualification and licensing criteria for the grade levels and subject areas in which the teacher provides instruction;
 - b. Is teaching under emergency or other provisional status through which State qualification or licensing criteria have been waived and
 - c. Is teaching in the field of discipline based on the teacher's certification.

2. Whether the student is provided services by paraprofessionals (instructional aide) and, if so, their qualifications.

Schools qualifying as a Title I School-Wide Program within Dry Creek JESD include Antelope Crossing Middle School, Antelope Meadows Elementary, Barrett Ranch Elementary, Coyote Ridge Elementary, Creekview Ranch School, and Olive Grove Elementary.
