Security Measures

As part of our commitment to the safety and well-being of our students, staff, and visitors, we have implemented measures to maintain a secure and focused learning environment. Please review the following procedures:

Accessing Richland High School During Operating Hours:

- Before School: New security gates near all parking lots will be accessible for entry onto campus. These gates will lock promptly after the tardy bell.
- During the Day: Doors and gates will unlock during passing times to allow movement around campus. This includes students arriving later in the day, such as Tri-Tech or Running Start students.
- Late Arrivals and Guests: All late-arriving students and visitors must check in through the new entrance on Long Avenue, where our staff will greet you. This also applies to students returning from appointments.

Visitor Policy

All guests must check in and out at the new entrance and receive a guest ID badge for the duration of their visit. Identification will be required to receive a visitors badge.

Cell Phone Policy

To minimize distractions and disruptions, both RHS and HHS are committed to not using cell phones during class time. The following procedures will be implemented:

- Students will have designated areas in the classroom to store their phones or can keep them in their backpacks.
- Cell phones may be used before and after school, during passing times, and at lunch.

Identification Badges

All students and staff will be required to wear their RSD-issued ID badges.

- Lanyards will be provided on the first day of school and students will be required to wear these during school hours.

Chromebooks

ATTENTION: Accepting chromebook terms and accepting or declining insurance MUST be completed for EACH student EACH year through FamilyID.

- Students who attended RSD last year kept their Chromebooks, but still need to fill out FamilyID for terms and insurance.
- NEW Students will receive a Chromebook the first week of school. FamilyID terms and insurance MUST be filled out for student to receive the chromebook.
- Students are expected to have their Chromebooks charged and ready to use each day for their educational activities.

Students who have completed registrations on FamilyID may pick up their Chromebooks in the Library

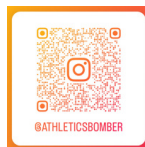
