(TRACY, CA) – Tracy Unified School District has named Dr. Michael Bunch as Director of Continuous Improvement, State & Federal Programs; and Ms. Erin Quintana as Director of Human Resources & Employee Relations. Both are currently directors in different departments and will be transitioning into their new roles during the next few weeks as part of a reorganization of departments and job duties.

Bunch was first hired by TUSD in 2017, as the principal of George Kelly School and in 2021 was named Director of Human Resources & Employee Relations. Prior to that, he held positions in other districts including principal, vice-principal and 8th grade teacher. He received his Bachelor's Degree in History from CSU Los Angeles, his Master of Arts in Educational Leadership and his Doctorate in Educational Leadership from University of Pacific.

Quintana was first hired by Tracy Unified in July of 2016, as an assistant principal for both Villalovoz Elementary School and Jacobson Elementary School. A year later she was named principal of Villalovoz Elementary School and in 2021 took on the role of Director of Professional Learning & Curriculum. For the past two months she was Director of Curriculum and Accountability. Her experience also includes being an administrator at Lammersville Unified School District and teaching for Tracy Learning Center and Tracy Unified. She earned her Bachelor of Arts in Criminal Justice from CSU Stanislaus and a Master of Arts in Educational Leadership & School Development from Teachers College of San Joaquin.
