


The above consequences will be administered based on the circumstances and severity of the infraction. Consequences appear as Level 1-3 with the understanding that depending on the severity, the first offense may be consequence at Level 3.

Students who are suspended from school will not be allowed to participate in after school activities and/or privileges that include, but not limited to: athletic games and practices (fan or participant), extra-curricular activities and meetings, dances/proms, field trips, graduation ceremony, etc.. Any student found to have violated this rule will receive additional consequences.

Students who are suspended from school for any of the reasons above, or consequence for a violation relating to academic integrity may be precluded or removed from an Honor Society.

Any suspension requires a re-entry meeting with the student, parent / guardian, and administrator on the day the student returns to school.

Code of conduct infractions and consequences can be viewed on the Genesis parent portal.

The Administration reserves the right to administer alternate consequences as necessary.
