Open Meeting

Brad Mansfield opened the meeting at 10:00 am on 02/26/24.

Topics of Discussion

Brad Mansfield started with an overview of a presentation planned for the middle schools and high school. The presentation is *Unintended Consequences* and it will be presented by Donna Hansen, Felony Division Chief of Montgomery County District Attorney's Office and Dr. Jordan Witkop. The presentation is required due to Tucker's Law that was passed last summer requiring fentanyl presentations for 6-12 grades. Presentations are scheduled for April 5 and May 13 for LLMS and BMS, respectively.

In addition, sixth graders at both middle schools have completed a 13-week Substance Use Prevention Program from the State called *All-Stars*. Seventh graders at BMS will also be participating. Tri-County's Substance Prevention staff will facilitate the sessions for WISD.

Caroline Cruz added that Texas AgriLife Extension has presented the Watch UR BAC Program that offers *Drugs and Alcohol Trends* in youth presentation. It is geared toward adults and was presented last May.

Michele Scaife gave a presentation as an overview of a program from Texas AgriLife Extension called *Learn Grow Eat Go & Walk Across Texas in Willis ISD*. The program targets socioeconomically challenged students to introduce skills for growing their own food, cooking their food, getting adequate movement, and more in an effort to foster a healthy lifestyle.

Old Business

As an update to the WISD Wellness Policy, Brad Mansfield mentioned that communication is forthcoming with PE teachers to support more and different activities for students either outside of school or during recess. There will also be communication to also address getting teachers and parents more active.
