Responsibility of A "Pet Plant"

According to NewsELA, people bring houseplants as gifts to their friends since it brings them joy. It's fun to watch them grow, change, and bloom. Some plants that are gifted are outdoor plants, which attract bees, butterflies, or other pollinators. Some of those outdoor plants you can eat after they're done growing!

Plants can be like pets. They need to be cared for, like giving them food, water and sunlight. To make sure you're taking good care of the plant, you need to do your research. You need to make sure that they're in the perfect climate to grow and thrive. Make sure to check and do research if their annuals or perennials. Annuals tend to die at the end of the year while perennials come back year



after year. Depending on what plant it is, it might need more or less water, sun or shade, special soil, or if it's an indoor plant, a sunny window or shady corner. Buy a pot with drainage holes at the bottom so water

can drain so the plant's roots don't become waterlogged. "Some plants need extra nutrients to help them grow." So if a plant needs extra nutrients, you can get a product called fertilizer. Make sure to read the directions, wear gloves and wash your hands afterwards! "Most fertilizers add a boost of three important ingredients: nitrogen, phosphorus and potassium." Altogether it helps with growth, color, and protection against disease. These ingredients can help make a healthy, growing plant!

The percentage of teens reporting they used any bad substances in 2023 continued to hold steady below the pre-pandemic reported in 2020, with over 10.9% of 8th graders, 19.8% of 10th graders, and 31.2% of 12th graders reporting any illicit drug use in the past year. Reported use for almost all substances decreased dramatically between 2020 and 2021, after onset of the COVID-19 pandemic and related

changes like school closures and social. In 2022, the most reported substance use among teenage kids stayed at these lowered levels, and these latest data show that the problem has continued all the way to 2023.

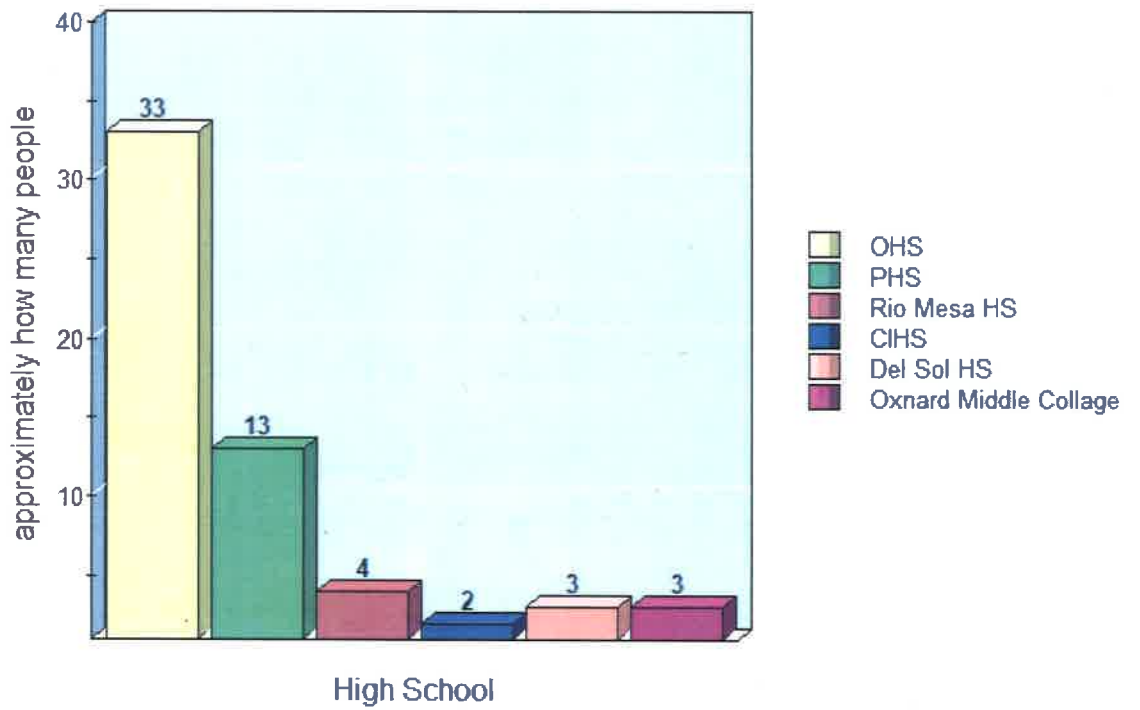

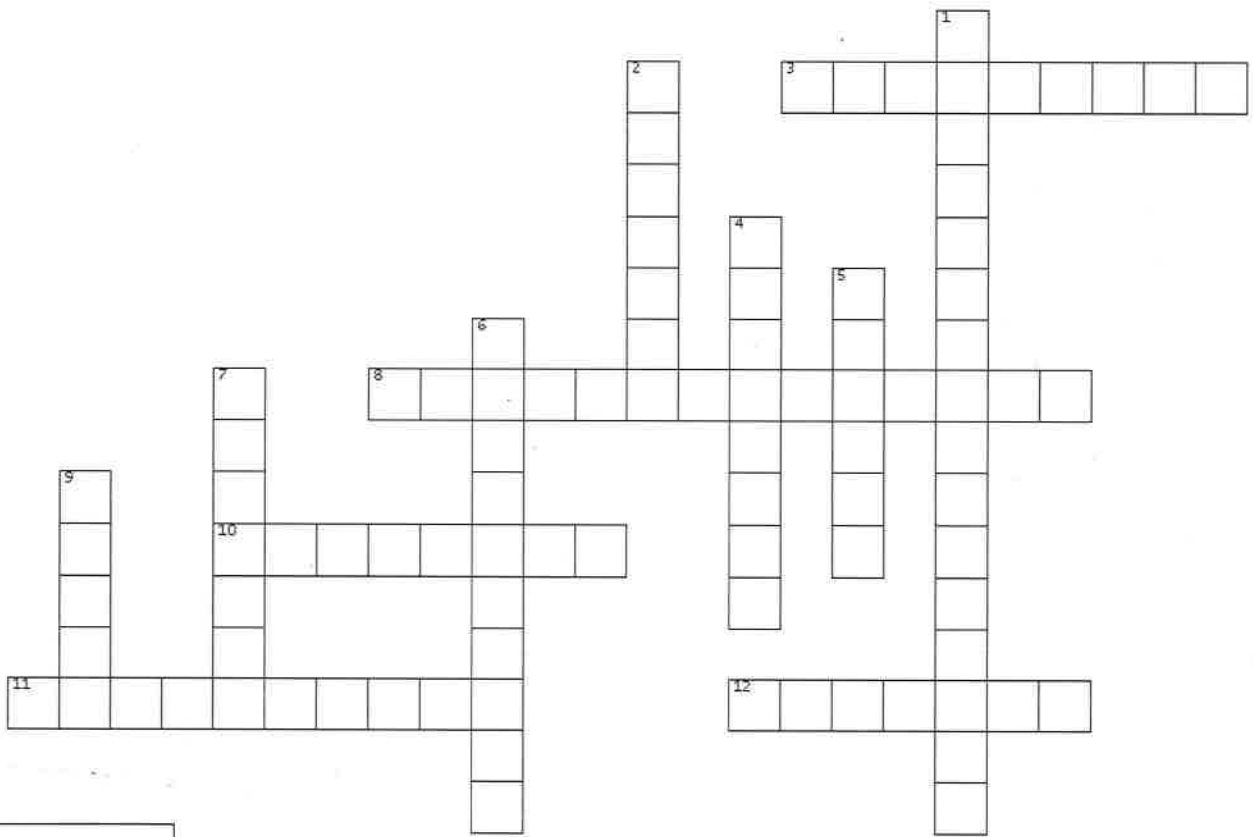
