#5 Travel and Exposure- Our team provides tremendous opportunities throughout the year to visit college campuses, attend industry tours, and travel to competitions. VIKotics team member have had the opportunity to fly on an airplane for the first time, see the ocean for the first time, and interact with students from across the northwest and the world. Much fun and memories are created on our travels, and we take pride on giving students the opportunity to see the northwest and learn about educational and career opportunities.

#4 Values of persistence and perseverance- "A dream doesn't become reality through magic; it takes sweat, determination and hard work." We set goals as VIKotics members, as individuals and a team. Gracious professionals learn and compete at a high level, but treat each other with respect and kindness in the process.

How GP plays into being a VIKotic is that we show up to competitions with the attitude "how can we help?" We help other teams, we help set up the field, and we help by encouraging others. I believe volunteering is a learned skill; even if required initially, We strive to teach VIKotics members to learn to appreciate helping others, and in turn become lifelong volunteers within their workplace and community.

#1 A place to belong- not to perform- A great quote from an FRC student when asked why they are involved, was: "In FIRST I'm lifted up for what I learn, not put down for what I don't know." A successful FIRST team is MUCH MORE than robots. It includes aspects of business, creating marketing plans, photography, videography, presentations, promoting our team by hosting booths at local community days and the local fair. All these

elements have nothing to do with coding a robot, understanding electronics, or fabricating parts with power tools. If students want a place to feel valued and a place to belong, we believe that can be found as a VIKotic.
