Inappropriate Language Excessively vulgar language Severe verbal threats against anyone Sexual harassment Racial harrassment Bomb threats- verbal or written Gang harassment Threats of punching/hitting Gang like behaviors Bullying Extortion</p> <p>2. Physical Contact Spitting Physical intimidation of faculty/staff/student Sexual assault Fighting/Physical assault</p> <p>3. Defiance Walking out of classroom Leaving your class while in the hallway</p> <p>4. Disruption Throwing objects with intent to harm others</p> <p>5. Property Misuse Vandalism Major graffiti Setting fires Use of combustibles (fire crackers, snap, etc.)</p> <p>6. Attendance Skipping class Hiding on premises Tardy (4+) Truancy</p> <p>7. Other Possession of weapons (any) Alcohol/drug possession/sale/use Tobacco use or possession/sale/use Possession of ignitors Technology Violations Academic Dishonesty Theft</p>
