A la Carte Purchases—Positive Balance Required

A positive account balance will be required for purchase of second entrees or other a la carte items.

School Breakfast

Breakfast is served each morning before school starts. Please encourage your student to participate in school breakfast. Research studies show that eating breakfast can help students perform better in the classroom.

School Lunch

Students will have a choice of entrées, a hot vegetable, and milk choices, plus the unlimited Fruit & Veggie bar.

A la Carte/Second Entrées

Middle and high school students have a limited variety of a la carte items, including second entrées, available during breakfast and lunch periods. Parents/guardians are responsible to pay for items their children take, so please visit with your students about extra items they may or may not purchase. A positive account balance is required for purchase of a la carte items.
