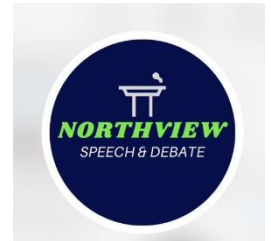

SUPERINTENDENT'S STUDENT ADVISORY COUNCIL – apply now! Deadline 9/6/2024


