

DEVICE FAQ



IF DAMAGE OCCURS OUTSIDE OF SCHOOL, SUCH AS HOUSE FIRE/FLOOD, CAR ACCIDENT, IS THE STUDENT RESPONSIBLE FOR DAMAGE?

- Yes, the student is responsible for the fine if the device is damaged outside of school - with the exception of fire/flood.

WHAT HAPPENS IF SOMEONE ELSE DAMAGES MY DEVICE?

- The family will need to provide proof and the fine can be assigned to the student responsible.

IF ANOTHER STUDENT INTENTIONALLY DAMAGES THE DEVICE OR IS ACTING IN A RECKLESS MANNER AND CAUSES DAMAGE TO ANOTHER DEVICE, WHICH STUDENT IS RESPONSIBLE?

- The family needs to provide proof and the fine can be assigned to the student responsible.

IF A STUDENT LOANS A CHARGER OR ACCESSORY TO ANOTHER STUDENT AND IT IS LOST, WHO IS RESPONSIBLE?

- The student should not loan the charger or other accessories. The assigned owner of the charger/accessory is responsible for keeping control of their items.



CAN MY STUDENT USE THEIR OWN DEVICE EXCLUSIVELY AND NOT TAKE POSSESSION OF AN FCS DEVICE?

- Students must use an FCS device for all testing.

ARE PARENTS NOTIFIED IMMEDIATELY AFTER EACH BROKEN DEVICE?

- Yes, parents will receive email notifications for all damaged devices caused by their student, along with the associated fine.
