Dear Parents, Guardians and Caregivers,


In accordance with Texas Education Code 38.222 the Board of Santa Maria ISD has adopted legal board policy FFAC to allow authorized employees, who have been adequately trained, to administer an unassigned opioid antagonist. An opioid antagonist, Narcan Spray, will be administered to a person who is reasonably believed to be experiencing an opioid related drug overdose.

Authorized and trained individuals may administer Narcan Nasal Spray at any time to a person experiencing an opioid related drug overdose on a school campus.

The District will ensure that each campus has a sufficient number of school personnel and volunteers that are trained to administer Narcan Nasal Spray so that at least one trained individual is present on campus during regular school hours.

De acuerdo con el Código de Educación de Texas 38.222, la Junta del Distrito Escolar Independiente de Santa Maria ISD ha adoptado una póliza legal FFAC que permite a empleados autorizados, que han sido adecuadamente capacitados, administrar un antagonista opiode no asignado. Un antagonista opiode, Narcan Spray, será administrado a una persona que se cree razonablemente que está experimentando una sobredosis de drogas relacionada con opioides.


Las personas autorizadas y capacitadas pueden administrar Narcan Nasal Spray en cualquier momento a una persona que esté experimentando una sobredosis de drogas relacionada con opioides en un campus escolar.

El Distrito se asegurará de que en cada campus haya un número suficiente de personal escolar y voluntarios capacitados para administrar Narcan Nasal Spray, de manera que al menos una persona capacitada esté presente en el campus durante el horario escolar regular.
