A. <u>Student/Staff Recognitions</u> –

- 1. The National Merit Scholarship Corporation (NMSC) announced over 2,600 winners of National Merit Scholarships financed by U.S. colleges and universities, including Seneca Valley's own Mr. Daniel Spear, a recent 2022 graduate and co-valedictorian, has been offered a National Merit Purdue University Scholarship. Officials of each sponsor college selected their scholarship winners from among the Finalists in the 2022 National Merit Scholarship Program who plan to attend their institution. Daniel intends to attend Purdue University this fall as a computer science major.
- 2. Mr. Chris Helmsen, a recent 2022 Seneca Valley graduate, has been named a National Cyber Scholar by the National Cyber Scholarship Foundation (NCSF) for his performance in a challenging online cybersecurity training program. Mr. Helmsen competed for a top score against thousands of high school students across the nation by solving real-world cybersecurity problems. Over 45,000 students nationwide sought to qualify for a National Cyber Scholarship. As a result of his achievement, Mr. Helmsen is one of only 20 students in the state who has earned a \$3,000 scholarship to attend the Cyber Foundations Academy, a multi-week online program based on the nationally recognized SANS Foundations training course and certification.
