- 1. Grant permission to apply for and disburse, if approved, the Highmark Foundation School Grant in the amount of \$7,500 for Connoquenessing Valley Elementary to continue the Leader In Me journey with the 7 Habits Signature Training, developed to ensure staff have a foundational understanding of the 7 Habits and their value in our school community. The Leader In Me program equips students with essential leadership and lifereadiness skills.
- 2. Grant permission to disburse the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection Environmental Education Grant in the amount of \$3,000 to implement a FarmFlex plant system at Ehrman Crest Middle School to enhance curriculum involving the food chain, photosynthesis, the water cycle and the importance of sustainability for fifth-grade students.
