2. **INFORMATION REPORTS**

A. Student/Staff Recognition

- 1. Seneca Valley Junior vocalists Allison Alexander and Elizabeth Hixon were selected to participate in the National Association for Music Education (NAfME) All-National Honor Ensembles (ANHE). Honor Ensemble participants are selected through a rigorous process that includes a recorded video audition. This year, Seneca Valley was the only school district in the state of Pennsylvania that had two choral students qualify for such a prestigious honor. This year's National Honors Festival was held online Jan. 22-24. The event included several rehearsals with six distinguished conductors, as well as workshops with special guest artists and renowned clinicians.
- 2. Daniel Spear, a graduating senior at Seneca Valley Senior High School, has been named one of more than 5,000 candidates in the 2022 U.S. Presidential Scholars Program. The candidates were selected from the nearly 3.6 million students that applied and are expected to graduate from U.S. high schools in the year 2022. Inclusion in the U.S. Presidential Scholars Program is one of the highest honors bestowed upon graduating high school seniors. Scholars are selected on the basis of superior academic and artistic achievements, leadership qualities, strong character and involvement in community and school activities.
- 3. Ten Seneca Valley students were selected for the Pennsylvania Music Educators Association (PMEA) District Orchestra in Sharon, Pa., Jan. 13-14. District 5 serves the music teachers and students of Beaver, Butler, Lawrence, and Mercer Counties.

 - 1. **Effective immediately (2/14/22)**, face masks will be strongly recommended but not required, indoors for students and staff in all schools during the day. *To avoid fluctuating between masking requirements, once the metric to discontinue the District's mask requirement has been met, masks will remain "strongly recommended but not required" until or unless the school board takes action to institute a new mask requirement.
 - 2. **Effective 2/21/22,** should the 7-day incident rate per 100,000 people for Butler county, as defined by the CDC, be lower on 2/21/22 as compared to 2/7/22, regardless of the community transmission level for Butler County, face masks will be strongly recommended but not required. *To avoid fluctuating between masking requirements, once the metric to discontinue the District's mask requirement has been met, masks will remain "strongly recommended but not required" until or unless the school board takes action to institute a new mask requirement.
 - 3. **Effective 2/28/2022,** should the 7-day incident rate per 100,000 people for Butler county, as defined by the CDC, be lower on 2/25/22 as compared to 2/7/22, regardless of the community transmission level for Butler County, face masks will be strongly recommended but not required. *To avoid fluctuating between masking requirements, once the metric to discontinue the District's mask requirement has been met, masks will remain "strongly recommended but not required" until or unless the school board takes action to institute a new mask requirement.
