B. <u>Student/Staff Recognition</u>

- 1. Seneca Valley Seniors David Choi, Zachary Garcia, Simren Jayaraman, Parker Logue, Ananya Rao, Avani Salunkhe, Anoop Savio and Dora White, have been named finalists in the 66th Annual National Merit Scholarship Program held by the National Merit Scholarship Corporation (NMSC). These seniors are eight of approximately 15,000 finalists and will now advance to the next level of the program where they will have the opportunity to earn a National Merit Scholarship and, ultimately, the Merit Scholar® title.
- 2. Possessing a 3,000-point lead and a total score of 32,631 points, the Seneca Valley Academic Decathlon team placed first and took home 12 medals at the recent Western Pennsylvania Regional Academic Decathlon Competition. The students competed in eight events: essay, art, economics, literature, mathematics, music, science and social science. The next competition will be against the top schools throughout the state later this month.
