## June 9, 2020

- 1. CALL TO ORDER Mr. James Nickel, President, called the meeting to order at 7:31 p.m.
  - A. Moment of Silence Mr. Nickel opened the meeting with a Moment of Silence and stated: "Tonight, as we hold our moment of silence, I ask you to keep in your thoughts Mr. George Floyd, whose funeral was held today and for his loved ones during this time of mourning. We also ask that you keep in your thoughts the lives of others who were killed through police brutality or racist attacks, including Breonna Taylor, Ahmaud Arbery, Jordan Davis, Oscar Grant, Philandro Castille, Freddie Gray, Walter Scott, Tamir Rice, Michael Brown, Eric Garner, Trayvon Martin and so many others who came before them. All lives matter, Black lives matter.
  - B. <u>Pledge of Allegiance</u> Mr. Nickel led the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.
