MINUTES

June 1, 2020

- 1. CALL TO ORDER by Mr. James Nickel, President called the meeting to order at 7:13 p.m.

 - 2. Seneca Valley Sophomore Veronica Pimenova was recently awarded a scholarship from Gannon University for her excellent work on a nanoparticles project for the Covestro Pittsburgh Regional Science and Engineering Fair (PRSEF). Each year,

approximately 1,000 students from more than 100 schools participate in Covestro PRSEF. Students spend a year leading up to the Science Fair developing and executing a project by utilizing a scientific method.

C. <u>Drug Testing Results Annual Report</u> – Dr. Matthew McKinley presented the results of drug testing during the 2019-2020 school year. The results of random drug testing were .42% (last year was .41%) and fell well below the national average of 2.7%. Follow-up testing results were at 0%, again well below the national average of 20% for follow-up screens. Eleven students were reported by staff as suspicious. These students had a health check and were then tested. After follow-up testing, no one was positive. Dr. McKinley believes that Seneca Valley is well below the national average because of the deterrents that are built into our policy. Seneca Valley has been conducting random testing for approximately 19 years. A panel of approximately 13 drugs are tested.

- 2. **I.U. IV** Mr. Eric DiTullio reported that out of 240 ballots, 194 approved and 0 disapproved the operational budget. The challenges of reopening in the fall were discussed. There will be another meeting at the end of June.
- E. <u>Legislative</u> Mr. Peterson reported that the \$25.75 billion General Fund budget was sent to the Governor to sign. Education was funded for a full year. The budget also provides \$7.5 million from the School Safety and Security Fund to address health and safety needs related to COVID-19.
