- G. <u>Transportation Loyalty Program</u> Approved a transportation driver loyalty program to increase the daily rate of our bus/van drivers and aides hired by ABC Transportation and Valley Lines for the Seneca Valley School District from October 2, 2023, for the remainder of the 2023-24 school year. This loyalty incentive is an effort to keep current drivers and promote new applicants. The district expects this monetary incentive to go directly to drivers from ABC & Valley Lines. Contract addendums will be prepared by our school solicitor for both ABC & Valley Lines transportation. Pending solicitor approval of addendums to the contracts.
