## SCHOOL BOARD WORK SESSION MINUTES

**September 13, 2021**

- I. **CALL TO ORDER** - Mr. Eric DiTullio, President, called the meeting to order at 7:11 p.m.
  - A. **Moment of Silence** - The meeting was opened with a moment of silence in Memory of September 11, 2021
  - B. **Pledge of Allegiance** - Laasya Masanam, a 2nd grader at Haine Elementary, continued the board meeting initiative, "I Led the Pledge" by reciting the Pledge of Allegiance.

- B. **Student/Staff Recognition** - Seneca Valley Junior Peter Ko earned the highest possible ACT composite score of 36. Fewer than half of 1% of students who take the ACT earn a top score. In the U.S. high school graduating class of 2020, only 5,579 out of 1.67 million students who took the ACT earned a top composite score of 36. The ACT consists of tests in English, mathematics, reading and science, each scored on a scale of 1–36. A student's composite score is the average of the four test scores.

C. **COVID-19 Update** - Dr. Vitale reported the following.

**From the Seneca Valley (SV) Dashboard, which is updated daily**

- 20 active student cases across the district with 56 students in quarantine
- 2 staff in quarantine
- No active adult cases
- Total currently in quarantine, adults and students is 58

**From the Covid-19 Early Warning Dashboard from the Pennsylvania Department of Health (PADOH)**

- Butler County's most recent 7-day period vs. previous 7-day period = 81 additional cases
- Incidence rate, most recent 7 days, per 100,000 residents = 255.5 cases
- PCR Positivity Rate for the most recent 7 days = 14.1%
- Difference in the average daily number of Covid-19 hospitalizations is up by 4.8

**Butler County**

- 14-day rolling average = 99.1 cases
- Cases reported on September 9 increased from 95 to 127; cases reported on September 10 totaled 137; cases reported on September 11 totaled 139; cases reported on September 12 totaled 72
- 7-day total incidence rate per 100,000 = 236.89 cases, high transmission level

**SV Zip Codes**

- 64 cases were reported over three days, Friday, Saturday, and Sunday

**Also being impacted by Covid**

- Bus driver shortage. Anyone interested in becoming a bus driver should contact Valley Lines or ABC Transit.
- Disruption in food chain for cafeterias. SV operates our own food services department and does not contract out this service. Looking ahead, we may need to reduce the number of food choices currently available.

D. **Agency Reports**

1. Vo-Tech - Mr. Fred Peterson reported on the JOC meeting of Thursday, September 9. There are over 1,000 students registered at the Vo-Tech with about 150 students from Seneca Valley. With the increased interest in welding and heavy equipment repair and operations, an additional teacher's aide is being hired.
2. I.U. IV - Mr. Eric DiTullio - No report
3. WPIAL Updates - Mr. Tim Hester, WPIAL Board of Directors Representative, reported that WPIAL has again signed with Heinz Field and the Pittsburgh Steelers to play the championship football games on Heinz Field, November 26 and 27, 2021. The 6A championship game will be played a week later with the site undetermined at this time. Multiple non-conference football games have been canceled due to COVID. WPIAL is experiencing a shortage of umpires and referees. Mr. Hester encouraged anyone interested to sign up for training to become a referee or an umpire. Lastly, WPIAL is conducting a food drive this fall to bring awareness to food insecurities in our area. More details to be provided.

E. **Legislative** - Mr. Eric DiTullio stated that he is following the property tax reform being proposed where there may be an increase in sales and earned income tax. He will provide an update in October. He also noted that the bus driver shortage is being addressed in the Senate and House of Representatives.

Mr. DiTullio noted that the in-slab heating system will save the District in resources typically dedicated to snow removal. The system will also prevent deterioration of sidewalks, flooring, doors, frames, thresholds as well as prevent slip and fall accidents. Mr. Randy Miller, Director of Buildings and Grounds, added that the cost came in under pre-bid costs and budget. Ms. Bredl noted that, over time, the system will be a cost savings in labor and salt supply.


