

Grading at FHS

- Progress Reports-Every 6 weeks
- Semester Grades- Recorded on transcript = Credits (twice per year)
- GPA on transcript from semester grades
- Letter grades given (no +/- at semester)
- Progress reports and Semester grades viewable in Infinite Campus



Physical Education (PE)

- Uniforms need to be purchased during the first week of school–Clothes will be sold Thurs/Fri.

- Completed physical exam (good for one year)




