

OLMA SPORTS AGREEMENT 2024-2025

As a member of the Academy at Our Lady of Mercy Interscholastic Sports Program, I agree to participate subject to the following conditions and requirements of the student handbook and the program rules of the Coach of my specific sport, under the guidelines of the Athletic Program.

- 1. Student-Athletes will display and encourage positive Christian behavior and promote good sportsmanship at all times.
- 2. Be prepared and on time, including having proper uniform/equipment at the appropriate times. Proper attire shall be worn for all activities
- 3. Players must inform their Coach if they are going to miss practice. It is only fair to the Coach, as he/she makes practice plans with each student-athlete in mind. Doctor's notes or Parent notes may be required.
- 4. Injured players are responsible to notify their coach, or the AD if unable to contact the coach, of any injury. Injured players are expected to attend all activities, including practice.
- 5. Student-Athletes are allowed to travel according to school policy, as long as it agrees with the Coach's requirements. Players must turn in a travel release form to the AD by 9:00 am on the day of travel.
- 6. Unsportsmanlike conduct will not be tolerated. Disciplinary procedures are to be expected.
- 7. Any disrespectful comments, pictures, videos, etc. of SELF, OLMA, teammates, OLMA staff, Coaches, or opposing team/coaches on any public or private website or social media is prohibited and will result in <u>Disciplinary Action</u>. Any information that is brought to the attention of a teacher, athletic director, coach, teammate, or Head of School will be addressed. Use of alcohol, illegal substances, and/or any drug abuse will also result in <u>Disciplinary Action</u>.
- 8. Players are to abide by the policies set forth by the Coach of their individual sport. They are also responsible for any notices that are delivered to them by the Coach.
- 9. The young ladies of the ACADEMY are to be representative and proud of the Athletic Programs at OLMA.
