Current state law allows students to bring cell phones/smart watches to school, with parental permission, for use during an emergency. District policy permits the use of cell phones/smart watches **for emergencies only** and their presence on school grounds will be allowed as long as students follow these guidelines:

1. Cell phones/smart watches are to be turned off while on school grounds except for extreme emergencies. Extreme emergencies refer to life- threatening situations where the school does not have other communication options available.
2. Cell phones/smart watches are to be kept out of sight at all times while on the school campus. This includes before and after school. ***If a student fails to abide by these rules, he/she will lose the right to carry a cell phone/smart watch with him/her during school hours. If the parent states that a cell phone/smart watch is required for after school reasons, it will be left in the office during school hours.***
3. Cell phones/smart watches are not to be used to call parents, friends, or relatives while on campus or in place of **school phones** except for extreme emergencies.
4. The school is not responsible for cell phones/smart watches brought to school and will not be liable for damaged, destroyed or lost cell phones/smart watches.

I give my child permission to have a cell phone/smart watch at school. My child and I have reviewed the guidelines listed above and agree to abide by these rules.

CELL PHONE/SMART WATCH POLICY

Cell phones are to be kept in backpack AND turned off during the school day.

Smart watches can be worn at school as long as they are not used to text, call or take photos.

First Offense: cell phone/smart watch turned in to the office- parent picks up

Second Offense: cell phone/smart watch turned in to the office- parent picks up and student loses 2 days of recesses

Third Offense: cell phone/smart watch turned in and parent picks up- privilege suspended
