### History & Community

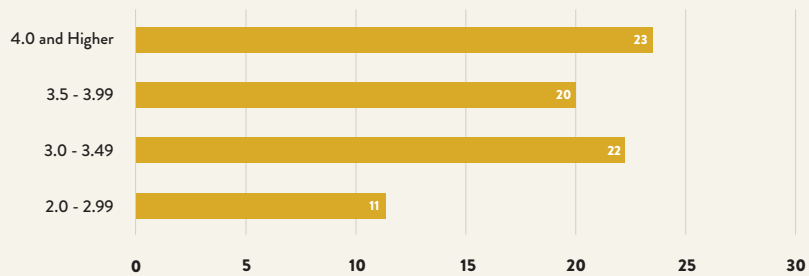
