

Trumbull High School has a bring your own device (BYOD) policy for all students. It is expected that all students have a device for their classes. Students at Trumbull High School may choose to bring their own devices to school. Any devices purchased or brought in must comply with the requirements in the table below:

Cell phones and iPads do not meet the requirements listed in the table above. Devices that students retained from middle school may be used as a BYOD device, but those devices are no longer supported by the district or eligible for insurance.

Students choosing not to bring their own device may choose to participate in the Chromebook Leasing Program. In this program, a device is provided by the district for a fee of \$45 per year. This fee covers insurance on the device for the school, specifics of which can be found in the [Chromebook Leasing Agreement](#). This program covers all accidental damage to the Chromebook or theft of the device subject to the following: \$0 deductible for the first two occurrences per year and \$50 deductible per occurrence thereafter. This coverage is effective for the duration of the school year. Insurance must be renewed annually.

Families experiencing economic hardship may request a fee waiver by contacting the appropriate school administrator and following the process outlined in [Board of Education 5138/Pay to Participate Policy](#).

Enrollment and payment for the Chromebook Leasing Program is processed via the [Infinite Campus Portal](#). To purchase the insurance, login to your Portal and select School Store on the left menu. Select Trumbull High School – Technology Fees – High School Loaner Program 2024-2025. Add the \$45 fee to your card and make your payment.

If payment is made by Friday, August 23, the student can pick up their device from the Media Center the first week of school. If a payment is made after August 23, the Library Media Center will reach out when the device is available.
