DANCE REHEARSAL ATTIRE:

The First Dance Rehearsal for this school year is this Tuesday 8/13/24 for Saintsations. We will meet in the choir room with check-in beginning at 5:50 PM. Rehearsal will begin at 6:00 PM. **Students need to bring a water bottle, and be dressed in their rehearsal attire.** Rehearsal attire consists of black joggers/black yoga pants/black leggings (not see through), socks, tennis shoes, and their rehearsal t-shirt. We will hand out rehearsal t-shirts on Monday afternoon for freshmen, and Tuesday during school for all other classes. You do not need to bring your performance shoes until September.

FRESHMAN ORIENTATION - SHOW CHOIRS SING!

Tomorrow, Monday August 12, the show choir members in grades 10-12 will sing the Alma Mater for the Freshman Orientation in the gym. Show Choir members should wear jeans/khaki pants, t-shirt or other modest shirt-no crop tops, and their show choir jackets. Mrs. Boone will send out a reminder to the show choir students today. We need as many students as possible to attend, and to support our freshman show choir students! We will be done no later than 3:00PM.

DANCE INTENSIVES for 2024-2025 COMPETITION SEASON!

Our first dance intensives will begin this Friday, August 16. The students will have about 20 minutes after school to get changed into their rehearsal attire: black joggers/yoga pants/leggings (not see through), and their rehearsal shirts. They also need to bring a refillable water bottle (with their name on it!). Check-in will begin at 3:20PM, and rehearsals will begin at 3:30PM. Anyone arriving after 3:30PM to rehearsal will be considered late. Dinner will be provided. If you have not previously alerted Mrs. Boone to any food allergies, please do so ASAP! Saturday's Dance Intensives will be from 9:00AM - 4:00PM. Lunch will be provided.

ONLY WATER WILL BE ALLOWED IN DANCE INTENSIVES! This also goes for all rehearsals in the choir room and theatre.

We will be learning approximately 75% of our competition dances during the 4 days of Dance Intensives. Attendance is mandatory. If for any reason you have to miss part of these vital rehearsals, you need to let Mrs. Boone know via email ASAP, (if you have already done this, you do not need to email her again). You are also responsible for contacting a dance captain and learning the dances missed. You will need to show Mrs. Best that you know the missed choreography in order to be in the dances where you missed choreography. This was announced at the May meeting.

STA goes to see "Newsies" at The New Theatre:

Students have the opportunity to go to The New Theatre's production of the musical "Newsies" on Saturday September 7! The price for tickets is \$40, and includes a full buffet meal as well as the performance. Doors will open at 11:45AM, buffet at 12:15PM, show at 1:15PM. Students attending will be expected to dress appropriately for the occasion (at least business casual - no jeans/shorts/flip flops).
