I hope this letter finds you well as our summer months come to a close. Fall semester and our access to the new space at Blue Water Community Action and St. Clair County TEC is right around the corner! I am happy to announce that we have keys and a finalized lease with BWCA 😊. Thank you for your patience and understanding during this relocation process, both this summer and throughout the school year, as we navigate renovations to our new space for VLA students.

Timeline and Important Dates

August 19–August 23

- Students are expected to work remotely and continue weekly check-ins

August 26–September 2: VLA is CLOSED (no daytime or evening chat support)

September 3: Scheduled hours begin Mondays through Fridays at VLA's new location (Blue Water Community Action - 3403 Lapeer Rd, Port Huron)

- Attendance at the building must be scheduled ahead of time with your caseload teacher

September 9, 11, and 13: **REQUIRED** Fall MAP Growth Testing for all students at the RESA East Campus Building (1111 Delaware, Marysville) from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

- Please contact your caseload teacher for your assigned testing day

September 17: Scheduled hours begin on Tuesdays and Thursdays at St. Clair County TEC (499 Range Road, Marysville) in Room 100B from 9 a.m. to 12 p.m.

- Attendance at the building must be scheduled ahead of time with your caseload teacher

October 2: **Count Day**

- Students must log in on count day and complete minimally one activity in all open classes in Edgenuity. Students must also have weekly two-way communication with a VLA staff member for the four weeks of our count period, as we are a virtual school.

Blue Water Community Action Attendance

Students will begin scheduled attendance at VLA's new location at Blue Water Community Action (3403 Lapeer Rd, Port Huron) beginning on Tuesday, September 3. Attendance is by appointment only! We will be open at this location Monday through Friday from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m. Students will attend

based on their individualized attendance plan, which will be scheduled with a caseload teacher on either a morning or afternoon plan (**AM plan:** 8:30 to 11:30 a.m. / **PM plan:** 12 to 3 p.m.) Students should plan to enter through door C-3 in the west side parking lot. Staff will be there to greet you and let you in 😊. For students driving, please park in the far west side parking area by the light post with the “E” on it. Blue Water Area Transit busing is still available to all students who need it.

*Please note that we can only have five students on-site at a time until the renovation work is completed to meet school code requirements. This is why it is very important that you schedule your attendance with your caseload teacher.

St. Clair County TEC Attendance

Students will begin scheduled attendance at St. Clair County Technical Education Center (499 Range Road, Marysville) beginning on Tuesday, September 17. Attendance is by appointment only! We will be open at this location in Room 100B on Tuesdays and Thursdays from 9 a.m. to 12 p.m. Students will attend based on their individualized attendance plan, which will be scheduled with a caseload teacher. The good news is that we will not be limited to only five students here and will have greater capacity to bring more students onsite.

*All students are expected to follow VLA rules and expectations to an even greater level as we are guests in another school building that is not our own. Poor behavior will not be tolerated and will jeopardize your in-building attendance.

I also want to put on your radar that we will be mailing home student progress reports and our most recent newsletter next week, so be looking for that!
