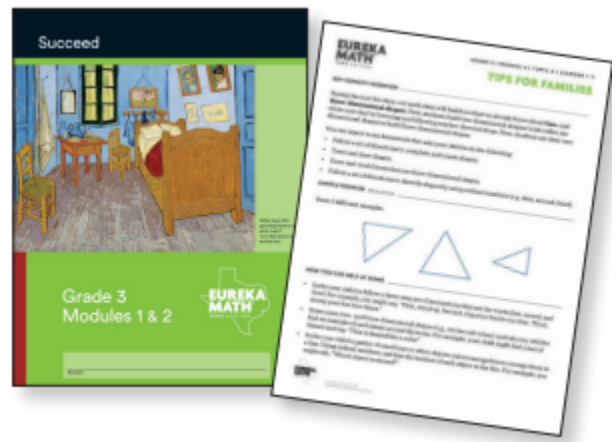
The curriculum goes beyond facts and formulas, teaching students to think about math conceptually. It helps students become not merely literate but fluent in mathematics.
