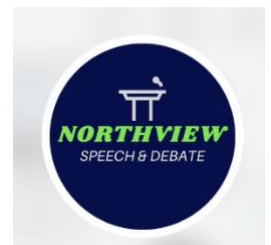


### PRINCIPAL ADVISORY GROUP
