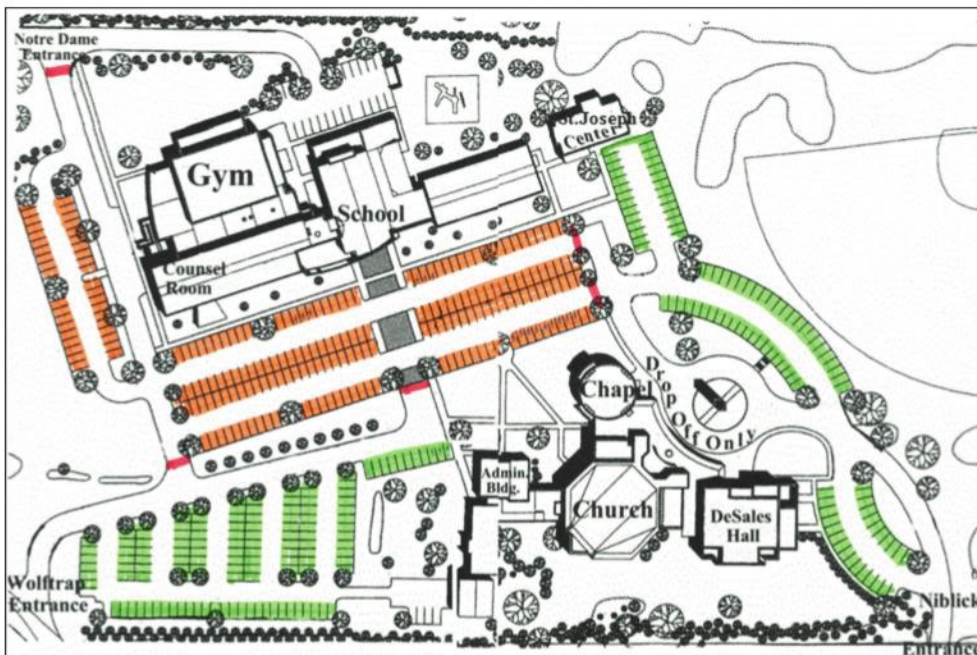

We will have a combined bilingual Mass at 10:30 that day so that 10:00 and 12:00 worshippers can celebrate together.

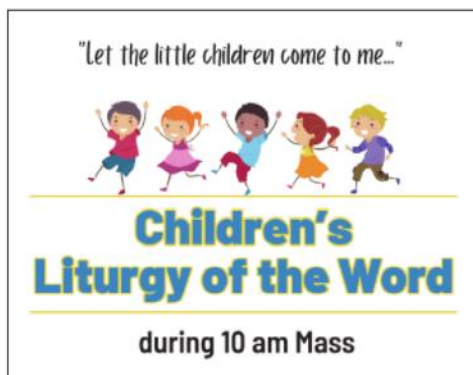

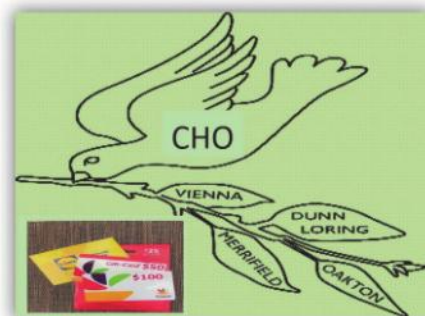
SEPTEMBER OUTREACH Gift/Grocery Card Collection for CHO

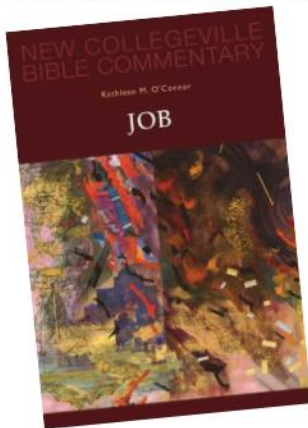

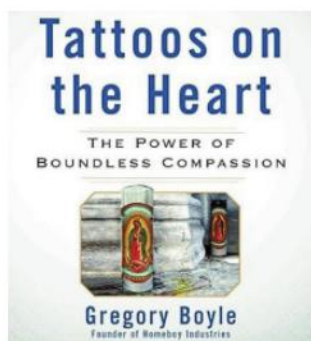


TUESDAY MORNING BIBLE STUDY

At the end of my term on the Council, I was encouraged to continue writing. There's never been a Sunday

without Senior Moments, except for the rare occasions when important parish news trumped it. I think the biggest challenge for me was to continue to write a small piece each week during COVID, for a severely abbreviated Bulletin, because the world had shut down and nothing was happening. But things improved and soon events and activities resumed.

So much has changed in those 25 years! Advances in medicine and technology have altered the landscape of health care. Opportunities abound for seniors to socialize, exercise, travel, take classes, and volunteer. Most importantly, numerous support groups flourish for those struggling to care for a family member's overwhelming medical needs at home.

It's been gratifying to know that every Pastor we've had at OLGC has been supportive of the senior members of our parish. Fr. John O'Neil was a beacon of support from the beginning, along with Merle Senyk, and Al Reichelt.

REFLEXION SALESIANA

Vigésimo Domingo del tiempo Ordinario 18 de Agosto
