

# RIVERDALE HIGH SCHOOL

*Please note: RHS does not provide school supplies, but we want to ensure your student is prepared for success. At a minimum, students should bring paper and a pencil to class each day. If your student is taking math, they will also need graph paper and a calculator.*

Below is a list of suggested supplies, with **bolded items** being the most essential:

## “Basic” Supplies

- **No. 2 pencils**
- Mechanical pencils
- Colored pencils
- Manual pencil sharpener (with a top to collect shavings)
- Large pink eraser
- Ballpoint pens (include red/green/purple/various colors for math and peer editing)
- **Spiral-bound or composition notebooks**
- Loose-leaf notebook paper (college-ruled recommended)
- Ruler (with both English and metric measurements)
- **Graph paper**
- **Graphing calculator**
- **Water bottle**

## Organizational Helpers

- Several **three-ring binders** (*some teachers require a dedicated binder for their class*)
- Three-hole punch (*one that fits in a binder*)
- Pencil case (*binder-friendly*)
- Binder dividers (*pocket dividers recommended for loose papers*)
- Folders for organizing paperwork
- Sturdy, supportive backpack
- Calendar or planner for scheduling and recording assignments

## Study Aids

- Index cards (*ruled and unruled*)
- Highlighters
- **Calculator**

## Home Computer Supplies

- Printer paper
- Ink cartridges

*Note: School computers are checked out daily but cannot be taken home. Students can print classroom assignments in black and white at school. If colored ink is required, printing will need to be done at home or elsewhere.*
