

Dual Immersion


- Develop oracy and foundational literacy skills in Spanish

- Reinvest dual immersion educators in the three pillars of dual immersion - bilingualism/biliteracy, high academic achievement in both languages, and sociocultural competence






Goals for ELIRTs


- Engage in coaching cycles that include professional development, collaborative planning, student work analysis, and observation feedback
- Synthesize the numerous components of the newcomer and dual immersion curricula to support teachers in utilizing them most effectively












Goals for Caregivers





Dual Immersion Institute

 100% of kindergartners that did not know all of their letters at the beginning scored proficient on reading silabas, palabras y oraciones

70% of 1st graders increased their reading fluency

Newcomer Academy

- She made incredible growth in all categories except directional commands.
- He did not make progress on his test. However, he just arrived to the US and struggled to write the following letters when they were said to him orally (a, e, i, c, k). He eagerly participated and expressed joy when he'd get things right. He was great at sorting the phonics words into the correct columns. He also was able to show growth in reading long vowel words. He would not attempt to read paragraphs or words outside of the phonics lesson unless a teacher read them first and he repeated.

Teacher Impact
On the second day of Imasul's in person PD, we had a lesson on phonics instruction and she had mentioned that she changed her PD for that day. It's probably because she came into my class and saw me struggling to teach the long a sounds. Her PD was excellent and it gave me useful strategies that I could implement right away. When I was teaching high frequency words and I was doing something wrong, I knew it, so I looked at Sidney and she provided the correction right there. Teaching HFW is new to me, and that **on-the-spot help was invaluable**.

Andrea provided excellent help on navigating the back end of VHL and showing me how to use the online portion. She also gave me great feedback on pronunciation for phonics lessons and helped me structure a lesson on the directional words to add more visuals.

I think this has been the single best opportunity for growth I've had in my teaching career. Unless something serious comes up, I would want to participate in this program each summer.

Marilyn took half of our class so that we could watch Sidney and Andrea give a lesson with the decodable readers. **The whole team was there to** answer questions, provide feedback, and be a support system. The PDs were thoughtfully created and allowed for implementation of new ideas and reflection on how our implementation went.

Please let me come back. I think you're starting something really special.

I loved working with the elementary teachers, too. It was a great mix of people. It was a lot of work, but the time was purposeful and useful. I liked the alternating planning and PD days. I would definitely continue to do those.

I think my success and enjoyment within the program is directly linked to the support we received through the PDs and observations/feedback, as well was the time we had to plan.

- Collaborated daily to plan for their teacher coachees
- Became experts in the many components of our newcomer curriculum
