This list not intended to be too detailed, but should give students and parents guidelines regarding the materials and equipment that students should have for available in all their classes.

General Supplies

-  Pencils, ballpoint pens, eraser and ruler (measuring in millimetres)
-  A geometry set (a set square, compasses and protractor)
-  Colour pencils, highlighters, glue stick
-  Pencil case
-  A ring binder and a set of dividers
-  Stationery (A4 lined and hole-punched)
-  A water bottle

Grade 6 – 7

Students need scientific calculators with fractions, powers and trigonometric functions.

Students should have graphing calculators, or at least scientific calculators with fractions, powers and trigonometric functions.
