**V. 2023-24 Building Goals**

Primary Building Goals - Dr. Gina Kirchner, Primary Principal shared highlights of the 23-24 goals for Primary Schools. Dr. Kirchner spoke about strengthening Tier I core instruction through personalized learning, continued MTSS Alignment, refreshing the PBIS system, developing proactive procedures to reinforce expected behaviors and clarify response to unexpected behaviors, exploring ways to foster a sense of belonging, working in committees to explore strategies to support students and staff in social & emotional development, and communicating changes to the standards-based report card through parent meetings, video support and teacher support.

Middle School Building Goals – Dr. Brian Bocian, WMS Principal shared highlights of the 23-24 goals for the Middle School. Dr. Bocian discussed renewed emphasis on PBIS, refining the MTSS process with the assistance of the MTSS coordinator, efforts to promote a positive school environment, collaboration between counselors, psychologist, and administration to assess and support social and emotional well-

being of students, and consistent and intentional structured communication for students, staff and families.

High School Building Goals – James Stallings, WHS Principal shared highlights of the 23-24 goals for the High School. Mr. Stallings discussed the use of data in MTSS progress monitoring, the six best practice instructional strategies, R factor engagement, actions supporting positive student culture and belonging, weekly communication rhythms, and planned activities during Flex related to social and emotional health.

**VI. Discussion: US News and World Report: Best High Schools**

Mr. Weber and Dr. Whitely shared the components of the calculation resulting in Wyoming's ranking as the 5<sup>th</sup> best high school in Ohio. They noted that the data for this year's ranking was from the 20-21 school year and explained each of the following criteria: college readiness (30%), state assessment proficiency (20%), state assessment performance (20%), underserved student performance (10%), college curriculum breadth (10%), and graduation rate (10%).

This discussion was postponed to a future meeting due to timing.



