Course Overview:

We will study and perform literature from a variety of musical periods. Students will learn to recognize composer/period style characteristics, interpret musical indications as scored for that period, and sight-sing difficult musical literature. Students will learn how to evaluate their own performance, as well as that of their section and choir.

Grading:

Minor Grades - Classroom Performance, Quizzes, Sectionals, Classwork – 50%

Semester Exam – 10% of the semester grade.
