REQUIREMENTS FOR THE VARSITY AFJROTC LETTERMAN'S JACKET TX-200210 WILLIS HIGH SCHOOL

Purpose. The Willis High School AFJROTC Letter recognizes cadets who have substantially contributed to the organization, demonstrated leadership, academic aptitude and a desire to serve their community. For a cadet to earn a recommendation for a varsity letter, they must meet the following requirements:

- 1. Cadets must have satisfactorily completed two full years of AFJROTC and be enrolled in the Academic Year they are recommended for the letter.
- 2. Earn an overall "B" Average in AFJROTC with no F's in any other course for the semester preceding the award of the jacket. Grades will be verified.
- 3. Graduate from a Cadet Leadership Course, or SASI approved alternative.
- 4. Successfully serve in a unit leadership position for at least one year.
- 5. Earn at least 40 points according to the below points schedule.
- 6. Recommended for award by the Cadet Group Commander.
- 7. Approved by the SASI. The award of the AFJROTC Varsity Letter represents Willis High School and Air Force JROTC. The highest standards must be maintained. A cadet could meet the basic requirements, but not meet the "whole person concept". Cadets not meeting the "Whole Person Concept", which involves overall attitude, moral character, self-discipline, respect for law and authority, personal behavior, military-bearing, honor and integrity, will not be recommended for the Varsity Letter Award.

Below are the requirements for cadets to earn their letter in AFJROTC. Each cadet must ensure their activities are properly recorded and provide any necessary documentation as needed.

COMPETE AT MEET (Drill, Rocketry, Color Guard, PT): 1 POINT

PLACE IN MEET (Drill, Rocket, Color Guard, PT) (1st, 2nd, 3rd): 2 POINTS FOR EACH TROPHY

COLORGUARD PERFORMANCES: 1 POINT

COMPLETE FULLYEAR AS PRIMARY STAFF MEMBER: 2 POINTS

COMPLETE 20 COMMUNITY SERVICE HOURS (with AFJROTC): 4 POINTS

COMPETE ON THE ACADEMIC BOWL TEAM DURING DRILL COMPETITION: 2 POINTS

COMPETE IN JLAB: 2 POINTS (for each round of competition)

MARCH IN CHRISTMAS PARADE AND/OR HOMECOMING PARADE: 2 POINTS (for each parade)

SCORE 80 OR HIGHER ON THE AIR FORCE FITNESS TEST: 2 POINTS

MEMBER OF NATIONAL, GERMAN, OR SPANISH HONOR SOCIETY: 2 POINTS

MEMBER OF KITTY HAWK FOR ENTIRE SCHOOLYEAR: 2 POINTS

AN "A" AVERAGE IN AFJROTC FOR SEMESTER: 1 PO|NT

FINISH IN THE TOP 10% OF THEIR ACADEMIC CLASS STANDING FOR THE YEAR: 3 POINTS

PERFECT ATTENDANCE FOR THE ENTIRE SCHOOL YEAR; NO UNEXUSED ABSENSES (OR TARDIES): 2 POINTS

SELECTED AS OUTSTANDING CADET: 5 POINTS

AWARDED ANY NATIONAL AFJROTC AWARDS: 5 POINT EACH

ATTEND CADET LEADERSHIP COURSE (Max 5 points each summer): 5 POINTS

DISTINGUISHED GRADUATE OR TOP GRADUATE AT CLC (Max 5 points each summer): 5 POINTS

CADETS MUST OBTAIN A **MINIMUM OF 40 POINTS** AND SUCCESSFULLY COMPLETE A MINUMUM OF 2 YEARS OF AFJROTC.
