

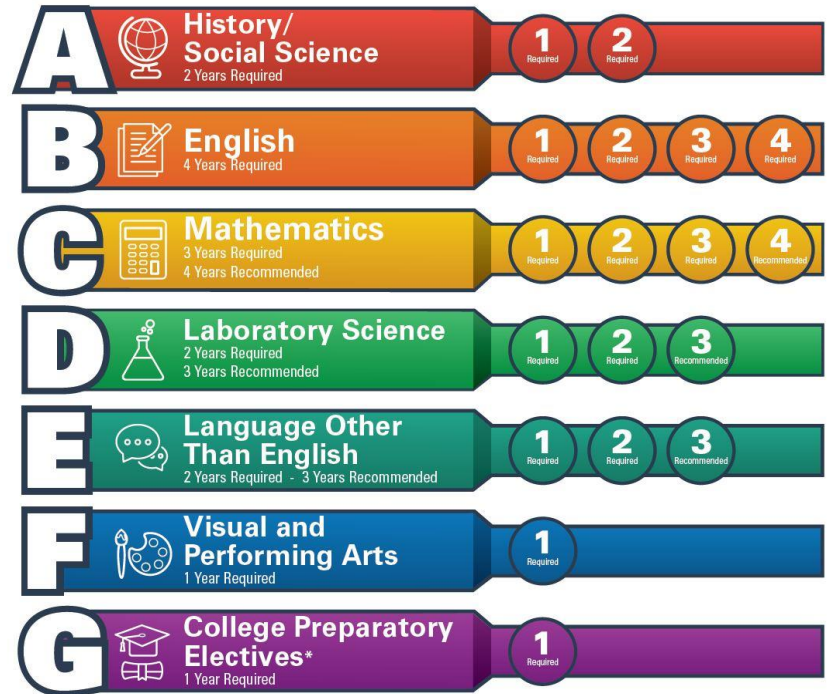

The University of California (UC) and California State University (CSU) systems require that students complete at least 15 courses in the areas listed below to be considered for admissions. Courses must be completed with a grade of "C" or better. Additional coursework beyond the minimum requirements is strongly recommended.

- Student textbook distribution will begin by the last week of August. Students will come in with their classes to pick up textbooks.
- Many of their books are due back by the end of the year so please encourage your child to keep track of their own books to avoid fees and confusion at the end of their high school careers.
- Should students want to use the library for study time, we do house a copy of almost every textbook for them to use the in library only.

LIBRARY INFORMATION & SERVICES

Library Rules

- No food, drink, candy, or visible gum.
- No cell phones or music players are allowed at any time in the library.
- Computers are for educational use only.
- Games are provided for student enjoyment. However, the library reserves the right to remove such privileges if they are used inappropriately or voice levels reach past those that are acceptable in a library setting.

Book Check-Out

- You may check out 2 books for 2 weeks each. Each book may be renewed unless there is a hold on it. There will be a charge for lost items. Class novels that are checked out for ELA lessons must be returned. Often times teachers require students to return them on their own time. Unreturned books incur fees.

Library Printing

- We provide 5 computers for students to use for printing purposes. Students can print assignments for classes or essential documents, but printers may not be used for personal items without staff permission.

Technology Fees:

- If the technology is broken/damaged- A \$40 fee is assessed.**

- Stolen laptops are not checked IF a police report is provided (students/families can speak to CRO about obtaining one.**
- Lost chargers- A \$10 replacement fee.**
