7th grade students are required to have the following immunizations:

- One dose of Tdap (diphtheria, tetanus and pertussis)
- One dose of MCV4 (meningitis)

If you have not already done so, please email, upload or send in a copy of your child's vaccine record as soon.

If your student has a potentially life threatening health condition (food allergies, asthma, diabetes, seizures, etc), please complete his/her Individual Health Care Plan. These are available in Final Forms and were emailed to you in the spring.
