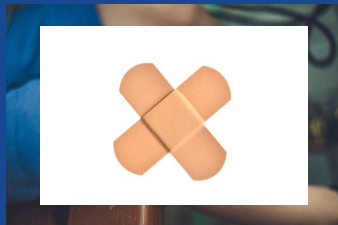


Fair isn't always equal...Fair is everyone getting what they need in order to be successful.



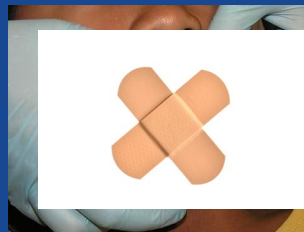

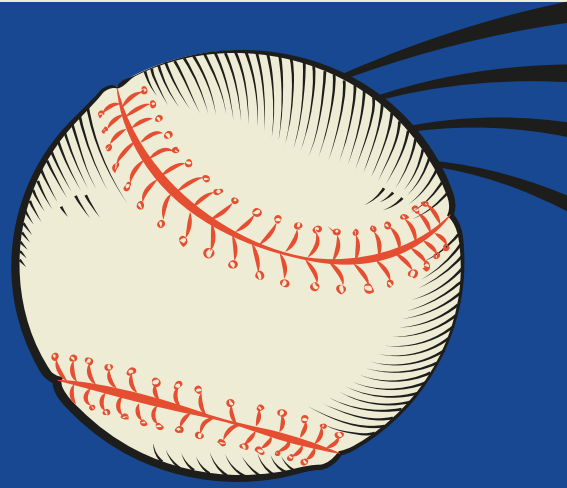
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“Home Run” Activity
