Do not take advantage of others

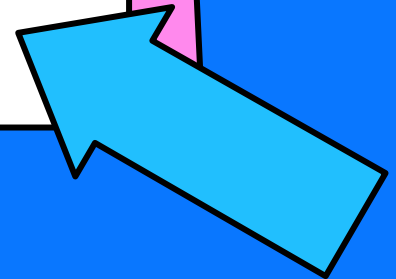
Be HONEST

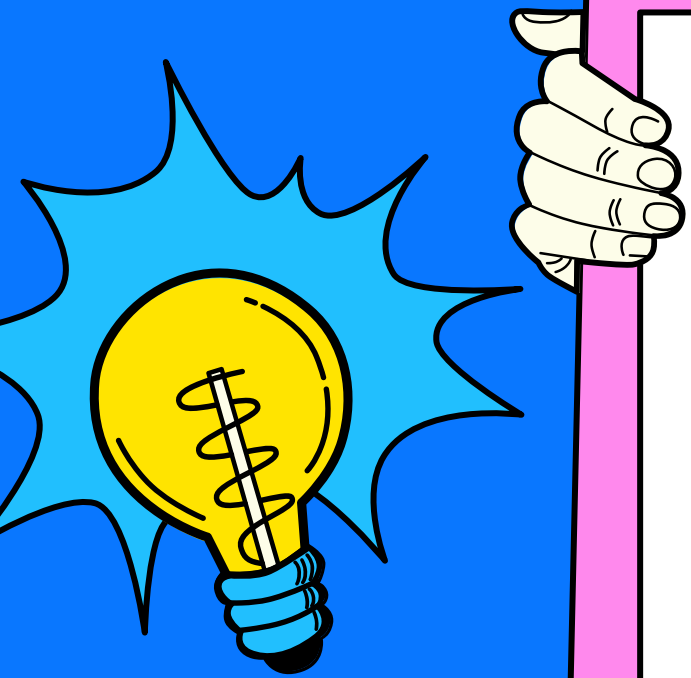
Take only your fair share or turn
