DISTRICT GOAL AREA 1: CURRICULUM AND INSTRUCTIONAL SUPPORT SERVICES- Raymondville I.S.D. will implement a well-balanced, challenging and aligned curriculum, instruction and assessment programs that promote learning at high levels and develop our students PK-12 with the necessary skills to be productive citizens in the world of today.

ANNUAL PERFORMANCE OBJECTIVE: 1.1 By the spring of 2009, 90% of the students will achieve mastery of the TEKS in Language Arts (listening, speaking, reading, writing, and viewing & representing) as measured by all the state and district diagnostic assessments.

ANNUAL PERFORMANCE OBJECTIVE: 1.2 By the spring of 2009, 85% of the students will achieve mastery of the TEKS in Mathematics as measured by all the state and district diagnostic assessments.

ANNUAL PERFORMANCE OBJECTIVE: 1.3 By the spring of 2009, 80% of the students will achieve mastery of the TEKS in Science as measured by all the state and district diagnostic assessments.

ANNUAL PERFORMANCE OBJECTIVE: 1.4 By the spring of 2009, 95% of the students will achieve mastery of the TEKS in Social Studies as measured by all state and district assessments.

ANNUAL PERFORMANCE OBJECTIVE: 1.5 By the spring of 2009, the district will implement strategies to promote a more effective and efficient process for identification and reevaluation of students who may be in need of special education services.

ANNUAL PERFORMANCE OBJECTIVE: 1.6 By the spring of 2009, the district will implement strategies to promote the Career & Technology Education State Goals: (1) managing the dual roles of family member and wage earner; and (2) gaining entry-level employment in a high skill, high wage job or continuing the students education at the post secondary level.
