VENTURING-BSA

Venturing is for Boys and Girls Ages 14 to 20

Scouting is a family-based program. Parent Volunteers are required to operate local Scouting programs.

- Offers year-round vigorous outdoor program, peer group leadership and service to others.
- Boys develop character, citizenship, and personal fitness.

- Based at First Reformed Church of Pompton Plains.
- Weekly Troop meetings where Scouts socialize and work on advancements and merit badges.
