DUAL CREDIT ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS: Students enrolled in dual credit eligible courses at Park Hill High School must meet placement qualifications. You can do this with a qualifying cumulative, unweighted GPA and/or ACT/Accuplacer scores. Dual Credit courses are \$60.50 per credit hour.

⁺The Math Accuplacer is a two-part test. Students must score high enough on the first test (Quantitative Reasoning & Statistics) to take the Advanced Algebra & Functions test, which will determine dual credit eligibility.

Now	<p>Step 1: Apply to MCC @ www.mcckc.edu/apply to generate myMCCKC online student account and ID number.</p> <p>Step 2: Review eligibility requirements on the other side.</p>
Week of August 19 th , 2024	Step 3: Complete the online “Intent to Enroll Form” provided during your dual credit class enrollment presentations.
Tuesday, August 27 th : 7:00 – 9:00 PM	Park Hill High School Open House - Dr. Miller will be available in the Media center hallway for questions regarding the enrollment process.
Thursday August 29 th @ 3:15 PM Wednesday September 4 th @ 3:15 PM	Accuplacer testing, if needed, will take place in the PHHS Media Center. Students must register for the test on these dates. Registration information is included on the ACCUPLACER Information Handout provided by MCC- Maple Woods Dual Credit representatives during enrollment presentations.
Friday, September 6 th	Step 4: Last day to submit the online “Intent to Enroll Form” AND take the ACCUPLACER, if needed.
September 23 rd	Step 5: Check your MyMCCKC to ensure you are enrolled in the correct courses. Contact Dr. Miller if your enrollment is incorrect.
October 10 th	Step 6: Pay in FULL for your dual credit class(es) OR sign up for a Payment Plan OR be dropped. (Dual Credit bills will be mailed to the student’s home address). All payments are made to Maple Woods.
