



The Falmouth Schools Nutrition Services Charging Guidelines & Procedures



It is standard practice for the Falmouth Schools Nutrition Services program to collect money for food purchases either in advance, (preferred), or at the time of purchase.

School Meals: Lunch & Breakfast are free to any and all enrolled students, ***permanently!!*** Second meals cost \$2.00 for breakfast at all schools and \$3.00 for lunch at the Falmouth Elementary and Middle Schools. A second lunch at the Falmouth High School is \$3.50.

A La Carte purchases: All items that are sold separately from a meal are priced individually. **There is no charging of any A La Carte item at any grade level, this includes for school staff.** This includes any milk or snack drink that is not part of a school breakfast or lunch. Students with negative balances will not be allowed to purchase A La Carte items.

Cashiers may remind students when their account balances are getting low. There are times, however, that a student comes to the cafeteria hungry and has no money either on their account or in their possession to pay for food or drinks. We understand that these occurrences are not intentional, and we will make every attempt to handle the situation in the most professional and courteous manner possible. **Students will be encouraged to take a complimentary meal.** The Kitchen Manager and/or School Nutrition Director will email parents when negative balances occur.

Please set up an online payment account at **MySchoolBucks.com**. Creating an account is **FREE**. It will allow parents to monitor account balances, receive LOW BALANCE email notifications, view purchases, and put money on student accounts, (for a fee). There is no fee when sending a check or cash with your student to give to a cafeteria staff member. All checks and/or money will be deposited immediately into the student's account.
