Each year sixth grade students are afforded the opportunity to participate in the Westlake City Schools Outdoor Education Program at Camp Nuhop. The sixth graders will attend Camp Nuhop September 9-11 this year.

Camp Nuhop emphasizes the study of nature in an outdoor setting and is intended to be educational. Classes are largely aligned with academic content standards. This activity also provides an opportunity for growth in the areas of social interaction and community responsibilities. Camp Nuhop is located ten miles west of Loudonville (about a 95-minute drive from Westlake) and features heated cabins with hot & cold running water and an on-site cafeteria.

Camp Nuhop has a permanent staff that plans and offers the instruction and supervision of lessons. Sixth grade teachers, support staff, and volunteers also attend to provide assistance and supervision.

The cost of Camp Nuhop is \$250.00. This covers tuition, room, board, supervision and transportation. Payment is due on Tuesday, September 3. Please make checks payable to the Westlake Board of Education.
