## ADVANCED PLACEMENT EXAMINATIONS

- In the 2023-2024 school year, 322 Charlotte Catholic students, in grades 11-12, took 929 AP exams in 22 subjects.
- 87% of the AP scores were 3 or above.
- AP examinations are mandatory in each AP course.
- **Students are afforded AP classes beginning in the junior year.**
- **Admission to AP courses is competitive. PSAT scores and grades in prerequisite courses are required.**
- 2 AP classes in the junior year and 4 AP classes in the senior year is considered a most demanding course load.

# THE CHARLOTTE CATHOLIC HERITAGE

Charlotte Catholic High School is a coeducational, parochial, college preparatory high school of 1,380 students, grades 9-12. Charlotte Catholic is an outgrowth of an educational program which began in 1887 at St. Mary's Seminary, in what is now uptown Charlotte.

Charlotte Catholic has been an integral part of the Charlotte community since 1955 and moved to its new campus in 1995. Although the majority of our students share the Catholic faith, qualified students are admitted without regard to race, creed, sex or national origin.

## COLLEGE MATRICULATION CLASSES OF 2022-2024

In the past three years, CCHS graduates have matriculated to **180** different colleges and universities. In the class of 2023, **77%** of graduates enrolled in public universities, and **23%** of graduates enrolled in private universities. **38%** elected to remain in North Carolina. **98%** of graduates will pursue post-secondary education with **97%** attending 4-year institutions and **3%** attending 2-year institutions.

## ATHLETICS

Since 2000, Charlotte Catholic has won 68 state championships and has been state runner-up 63 times. During that same time, Charlotte Catholic was named recipient of 8 Wachovia/Wells Fargo Cups, recognizing the top athletic program, by division, in North Carolina.

Charlotte Catholic is one of four parochial schools competing in the North Carolina High School Athletic Association. We currently participate in the Division 4A Southwestern Conference. Many of our student-athletes continue to participate in the NCAA.

## FINE ARTS

The Visual and Performing Arts Department works closely with students to achieve a high level of performance in music, dance, theatre, art, and photography. Visual Arts students are consistently awarded Gold and Silver Keys in the Mid-Carolina Scholastic Awards, with many Honorable Mentions.

Our theatre, band, choral, and dance programs all produce multiple performances each year in our state-of-the-art Fine Arts Center, dedicated in 2022. The band and choral programs are active performers nationally, having performed in New York and Chicago. The Charlotte Catholic band performs quadrennially in the St. Patrick's Day Parade in Dublin, Ireland.
